A dialogue among the disciplines organized by the Learning Development Institute, in collaboration with Sustainability Institute, Stellenbosch, South Africa as well as in association with Fundación Cultura de Paz Universe Awareness (UNAWA) United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)

This fourth colloquium follows in the footsteps of three prior Building the Scientific Mind colloquia, all of them under the patronage and/or with the support of UNESCO, namely BtSM2009, held in Cairo, Egypt, in May 2009; BtSM2007, held in Vancouver, Canada, in May 2007; and BtSM2005, held in The Hague, The Netherlands, in May 2005. This fourth colloquium is deliberately being planned to take place in South Africa so as to favor participation from sub-Sahara Africa, and countries in the southern hemisphere in general, while continuing the practice of the past colloquia to discuss issues regarding the scientific mind in a global perspective.
